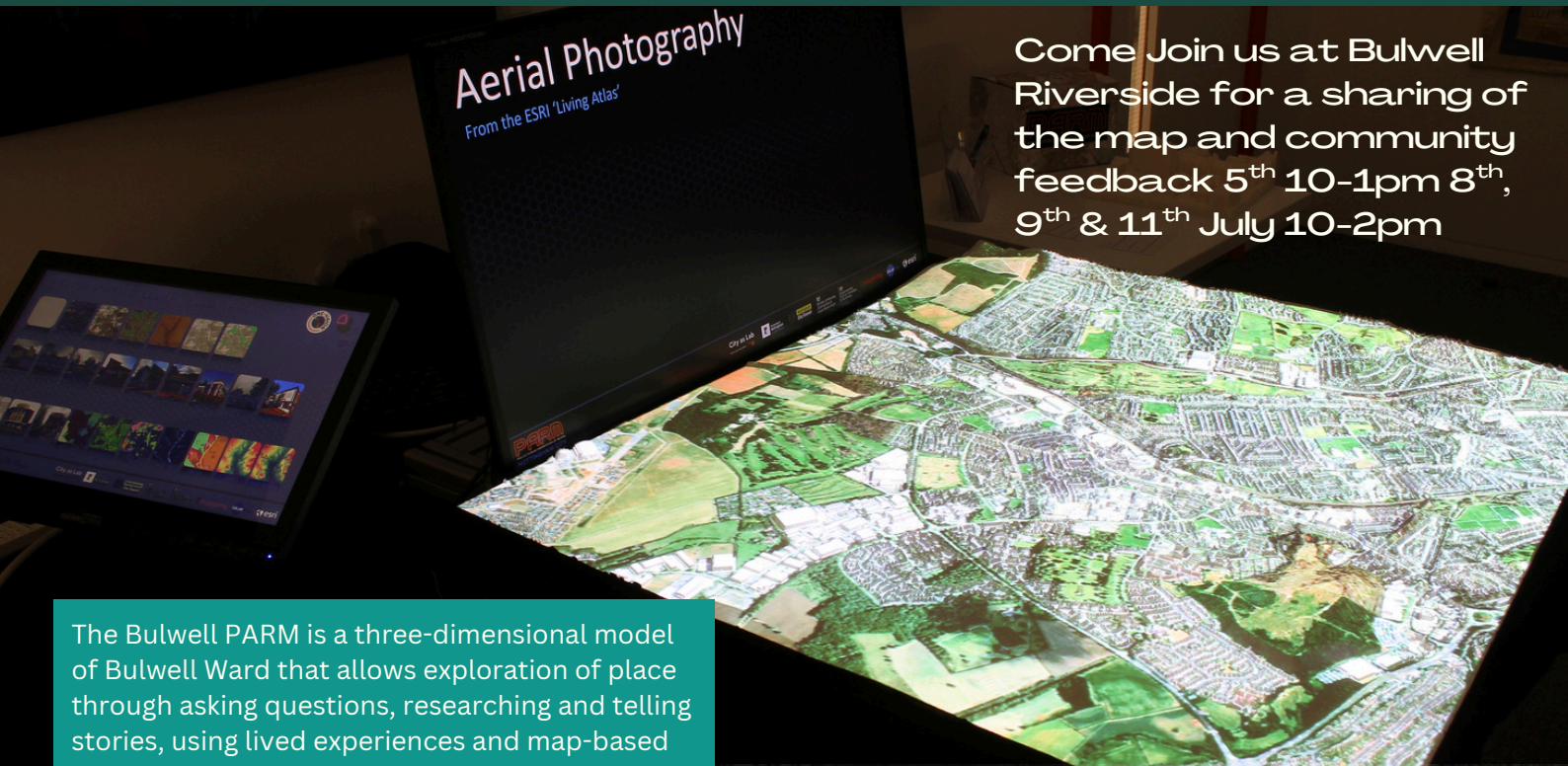

# PARM BULWELL

## Projection Augmented Relief Model

The Bulwell PARM is a three-dimensional model of Bulwell Ward that allows exploration of place through asking questions, researching and telling stories, using lived experiences and map-based data. The PARM will be situated at the Riverside Library throughout BAF and we hope to stimulate dialogue with local residents about their experiences, concerns and causes for celebration about life in Bulwell.

The PARM has been designed and built at the University of Nottingham, winning the 2024 British Cartographic Society Award for 'Map of the Year'.

### Bulwell Academy Year 9 "Pride of Place" research project

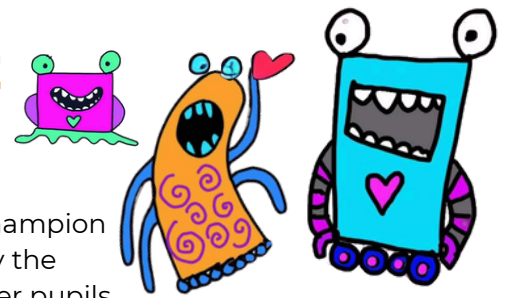


Dr Tara Webster-Deakin from the University of Nottingham, has been working with a group of Y9 pupils at Bulwell Academy, once a week since February 2025.

Using the Bulwell PARM to stimulate discussions about the pupils' perspectives on their lives in Bulwell, they have undertaken research into the experience of local residents and of pupils in years 7, 8 and 9 at their school. The pupils' research findings will be shared in the form of a piece of art by local artist Natalie Coe, and via the Bulwell PARM at the Festival.

# SCHOOLS COLLABORATIVE PROJECT- VOICEBOXES



In collaboration with ChalleNGe Nottingham, we are proud to partner with Bulwell Primary schools and alternative provisions to champion pupil voice through creative and engaging Voice Boxes. Designed by the children from each school, these specially crafted postboxes empower pupils to share their thoughts, ideas, and feedback. They ensure that every child, including those who may feel shy or hesitant, has the opportunity to be heard.

## NOTTINGHAM GAMES PROJECT



Do you call it Dobbie or Tig or Tag? Did you play hopscotch or What Time is it Mr Wolf? How many traditional playground games do you remember and how do new games get invented? The children of Nottingham primary schools have been researching the games in their playgrounds over the past year and have made some surprising discoveries. And with schools now focusing more than ever on the safety and creativity in the playground, the Nottingham Games project promises to have a real impact. Bulwell schools have been particularly active in researching the way the games are invented, revived, remembered and played today. The Nottingham Games book will be published later this year and will feature ideas that Bulwell children have researched.



For the Bulwell Arts Festival, children from several local primary schools will celebrate and share their research at a Nottingham Games tea party at Bulwell Academy along with invited guests of parents and older relatives. We predict that lots of discussion will take place about favourite games from the past and present. The event on Thursday 10 July will also be filmed as part of the outcomes from the city-wide project to include a book and documentary.

Our hope for the project is that Nottingham Games will create a wider interest in the games that children play and the importance of play in their lives.

The project has been supported by the National Lottery Heritage Fund.

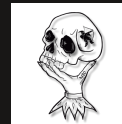

Nottingham City MHST (Mental Health Support Team) are an early help service working in primary and secondary schools, sixth form centres, colleges, SEND schools and alternative provision, offering children, young people and family access to early mental health support. They offer individual, group, and parent-led support for mild-to-moderate common mental health difficulties including low mood, anxiety, and behavioural difficulties. Alongside this, they work with educational establishments to develop a whole-school approach to mental health, with the aim of creating mentally healthy schools for children and young people to thrive in.
